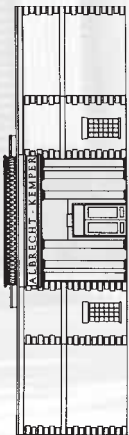

The Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art originated in 1913 with the founding of the St. Joseph Art League. With the hope of establishing a public art gallery in St. Joseph, the League

acquired the William Merritt Chase painting, *A Venetian Balcony*, which became the first piece in the permanent collection. The Art League opened the Albrecht Gallery in 1966 in the former home of Mr. and Mrs. William Albrecht. In 1993 with the opening of a new addition, the name was changed to

the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art. With a fine collection of American art, the museum continues to nurture regional artists and play a significant role in a complete art experience for museum visitors.

In addition, the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art has become a favorite venue for corporate and private events. Featuring an elegant and entertaining atmosphere, it is the perfect setting for your next special reception, luncheon, dinner or business meeting. The Terrace Dining Room and adjacent galleries accommodate groups of 20 to 250. Featuring some of

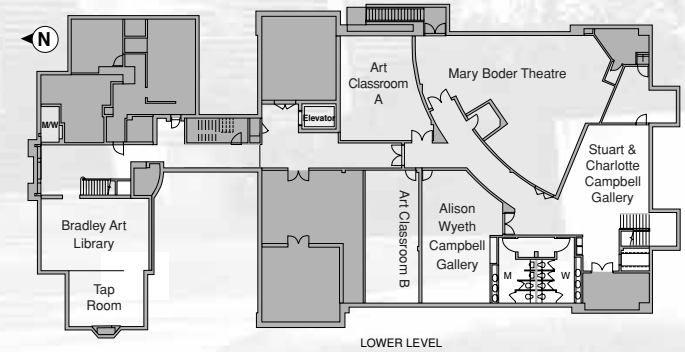
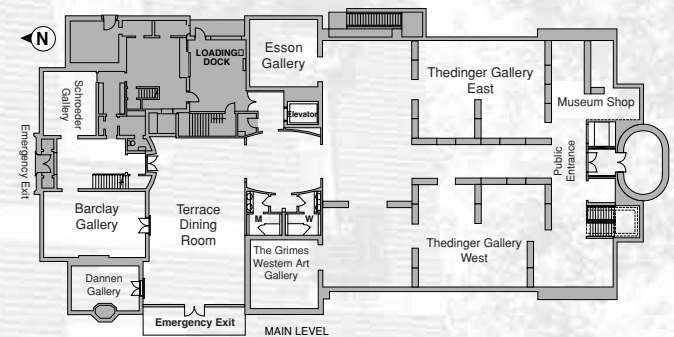
