- Artworks are judged in seven categories.

OFFICIAL RULES

PLEASE REMEMBER...HOW YOUR ARTWORK IS PRESENTED MAY AFFECT HOW IT IS JUDGED.

TWO DIMENSIONAL ART

- Must be suitably presented and ready to hang with wires firmly attached
- No sawtooth hangers, slot hangers, or glass and clips
- **Works on paper** must be matted and framed behind glass or Plexiglas. Please indicate if Plexiglas. No non-glare glass.
- White, off-white, or cream mats are the professional standard.
- **Painted canvases** must be stretched; frames preferred
- We will not accept warped canvases/frames

THREE DIMENSIONAL ART

- Must sit level and be properly based
- No work can be suspended from the ceiling

MAXIMUM SIZE: 6' x 6', including frame

MAXIMUM WEIGHT: 50 pounds

Please note: works involving multiple pieces must be joined together as one unit and must not exceed size or weight limitations of a single piece.

Works that do not follow these stipulations will not be exhibited

CATEGORIES

Each work must be assigned one of the following

SEVEN CATEGORIES:

- I. Painting: oil or acrylic
- II. Painting: watercolor
- III. Drawing: pencil, pastel, pen and ink
- IV. Printmaking: engraving, woodcut, serigraphy, etc.
- V. Photography
- VI. Sculpture and Ceramics
- VII. Alternative & 2-D Mixed Media

Artworks entered by an individual do not have to be in the same categories.
