## *Regional High School Art Exhibition 2006*

The mission of the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art is to bring the excitement of American visual arts to the region through education, temporary exhibitions, the permanent collection, and the nurturing of regional artists. What better way to nurture young local talent than through exposure in a museum-sponsored juried art competition? The *Regional High School Art Exhibition* is an invitational exhibition, with over 75 schools from Northwest Missouri and Northeast Kansas invited to participate. We hope your school will contribute artwork to make this year's exhibition the best ever.

**As outlined in the *Official Rules*, artwork may be entered into one of nine categories. Please note these categories closely as they have changed from recent years. Artworks are divided into categories based on media and/or technique. This is done so that each artwork may be judged more fairly against similar work. As you know, it can be difficult to compare a painting to a sculptural piece. This is why the museum reserves the right to change categories. If an artwork comes in and the exhibition committee feels that it would be judged more fairly in another category, the work may be reassigned to the more appropriate category.**

After a panel jury selection, *First, Second, and Third Place*, plus *Honorable Mentions*, will be awarded in each category. *First Place* winners in each category will receive a one-year **family** membership to the Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art. **New this year, to maximize attendance and to celebrate both the exhibition and Youth Art Month, the museum will waive admission fees during the exhibition. Please inform your students, friends, and families of this opportunity to visit the museum free of charge.**

Awards will be presented during a special reception for the artists from 1 to 4 pm Sunday, March 5. The awards ceremony will be at 2 pm in the Boder Theatre in the museum's Lower Level. ***Please make sure the students or at least one representative of your school attends the Opening Reception and Awards Presentation to accept awards for your school, and for photographic opportunities.***

**The deadline for entries is Sunday, February 19.** Late entries will not be accepted. All details, delivery/pick-up dates, and entry forms are enclosed. ***Requirements and dates must be strictly adhered to.***

# Albrecht-Kemper Museum of Art *Regional High School Art Exhibition Official Rules:*

The *Regional High School Art Exhibition* is an invitational exhibition, with over 75 schools asked to participate. Each full-time art instructor may submit five original artworks created during the 2005-2006 school year, not previously exhibited at the Albrecht-Kemper. Schools without a full-time art instructor may submit up to five artworks. Awards will be presented in each of the nine categories to *First, Second, and Third Place*, plus *Honorable Mentions*.

## ***Each work must be assigned one of the following NINE CATEGORIES:***

- I. **PAINTING:** oil, watercolor, tempera, acrylic, etc.
- II. **DRAWING MONOCHROMATIC:** charcoal, conte, ink, pencil, etc.
- III. **DRAWING MULTI-COLOR:** color pencil, ink, pastel, etc.
- IV. **PRINTMAKING:** engraving, lithography, monoprint, serigraph, woodcut, etc.
- V. **PHOTOGRAPHY:** black & white, color, digitally manipulated, hand-colored, etc.
- VI. **2-D MIXED MEDIA:** assemblage, collage, quilts, etc.
- VII. **CERAMICS:** CLAY—air dried or kiln fired, glazed or painted
- VIII. **THREE-DIMENSIONAL:** metalsmithing, sculpture, and other 3-D mixed media
- IX. **ALTERNATIVE:** media or artworks that do not fit into the above categories (for example: video)

**Complete the Identification Labels and Entry Form** printed on the enclosed page. The art instructor must fully complete the labels and sign entry form.

Securely attach an **Identification Label** to the back of each entry.

The **Entry Form** must be completed, signed, and delivered to the museum front desk with the entries. Do not attach the entry form to the work of art.

Deliver entry form and labeled artworks to the Information Desk (located at museum's south public entrance) according to the schedule below.

**TWO DIMENSIONAL ART must be ready for hanging. Framed pieces and stretched canvases must be wired. Works on paper must be matted. White or cream mats preferred.**

Attach artwork to mat with good quality tape (no duct tape).

Mats wrapped in plastic or acetate are not acceptable.

Painted canvases must be stretched; frames preferred.

*We will not accept warped mats/canvases/frames.*

**THREE DIMENSIONAL ART must sit level** on a base, or have adequate mechanisms and instructions for installation.

**Works using wet media** such as paint, glaze, or glue must be completely dry before bringing to the museum.

**Works involving multiple pieces** must be joined together as one unit and must not exceed size or weight limitations of a single piece.

**Maximum Size** is 4' x 4'; maximum weight is 50 pounds.

Works that do not follow these stipulations will not be exhibited.

*Works of art may not be removed from the museum during the exhibition.*
